ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The following requirements must be met by the applicant:

- a. Completion and submission of the application for admission form to the college academic registrar or his representative by the applicant.
- b. Certified copies of the Applicant's previous academic credentials
- c. Submission of proof of residential address of parent / legal guardian
- d. Two applicant's ID photos and two certified ID copies
- e. A parent/guardian's certified ID copy
- f. Proof of payment of a nonrefundable registration fee
- g. Proof of sufficient funds in the case of an immigrant applicant

APPLICANT / LEARNERS RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS

- a. The applicant/learner has the right to access to quality service during his or her time of study at the college, this right entails the right to attend lectures and assessments. It is therefore, the applicant's duty to inform the college in writing if she or he has observed that this right is being compromised.
- b. Student's failure to attend lectures for whatever reason shall not in any way entitle him or her to a reduction tuition fees nor will it absolve him / her or other signatories to this document from full obligation of payment of fees and charges.
- c. Brighton reserves the right to create and apply rules and regulations, including due performance; the students hereby agrees to be bound by such rules and regulations.
- d. The college shall have the right to alter any attendance timetables and to this effect a student has the right to be informed of such occurrences.
- e. Should Brighton College SA college take legal action for the collection of monies owed by the applicant, the costs will be the liability of the applicant; to avoid the former, the applicant must make sure that his /her fees are paid not later than the date stipulated.
- f. External assessments are compulsory in all programmes; it is therefor, the student's responsibility to ensure that he/she has been registered with the relevant examining/assessing body.
- g. The student's failure to either register or write examinations or attend assessments for what so ever reason shall not in any way entitle to him/her to a reduction to tuition fees.
- h. In addition to these terms of registration, the applicant further agrees to abide by the college enrollment terms and conditions and the student terms and conditions as well as students' rules and regulations.
- i. It is clearly understood that no unruly or disruptive behaviour by any student will be tolerated and that the college reserves the right to suspend tuition to the offenders without recourse.
- j. Queries must be forwarded to the students' liaisons officer in case of any dissatisfactions.

CANCELLATION OF STUDIES AND REFUND

The applicant has the right to terminate his or her studies with the college within a period of 5 days prior to the commencement of the course and must provide a motivation for cancellation. Full refund of the refundable fees will be made by the college on the condition of terminal illness or death, any other reason other than the conditions stated

herein will be tantamount to a 30% reduction on the total advance fees paid by the Parent/Guardian or funder.

Cancelation will be granted without contractual obligation and no cash will be refunded in the event that the applicant has transferred his/ her studies to another institution.

INDEMNITY

Neither Brighton College SA nor its representative/employee shall be liable for bodily harm/death/damage or loss of property arising from the applicant's negligence or misconduct.
